CALL FOR PAPERS

Research papers based on the conference themes and sub-themes are invited for oral or poster presentations. Accepted abstracts will be compiled in the conference proceedings, and full-length papers will be published with an ISBN number. Additionally, selected research papers will be considered for publication in a UGC-CARE listed journal. Any applicable publication charges for such papers will need to be paid separately upon notification.

GUIDELINES FOR PAPER SUBMISSION

- All submitted papers must be original, unpublished, and not under consideration for publication in any other journal or conference proceedings.
- The abstract should not exceed 250 words and should include 4-5 keywords.
- Papers must be submitted in Microsoft Word format.
- The paper must be formatted in Times New Roman font, with size 12 for the main text, size 14 for headings, and 1-line spacing. Margins should be set to 1 inch on all sides, and the text should be justified. Tables and figures must be properly numbered.
- The full-length paper should not exceed 7 pages.
- Below the title, provide the author's and co-author's names, institution name, and email addresses.
- Oral paper presentations will be limited to 10 minutes: 7 minutes for the presentation and 3 minutes for discussion.
- For poster presentations, the size of the poster should be 1m x 1m.
- Notifications regarding the acceptance of submitted abstracts and papers will be sent via email.
